Pastoral Care Updates:

Dear Families and Friends of Vincentian de Marillac,

Yesterday we celebrated the first Sunday of Advent, our chapel is decorated with our simple but beautiful Advent wreath with its four candles. The first two Sundays of this holy pre-Christmas season invite us to contemplate the second and glorious coming of our Lord Jesus Christ at the end of time. Your loved ones and I have been discussing our Christian hope of resurrection from the dead based upon the victory won by Jesus at Easter and the final, glorious close of history marked by the mysterious events foretold in sacred scripture. Of particular interest is the promise of our Lord that we will ultimately share fully in His risen life when our souls are reunited with our glorified bodies on the last day. As we repeat every Sunday and Solemnity, "I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come." This focus on the second coming of our Lord during the first two weeks of Advent sets the stage for us to understand fully His first coming. "The angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid; for behold, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all people. For today in the city of David a Savior has been born for you who is Messiah and Lord.'" (Luke 2:10-11) Our residents, your beloved family members, and friends, at the twilight of their earthly pilgrimages, have welcomed with joy and enthusiasm this proclamation of our Christian hope. Jesus comes into the world to win victory over sin, death, and the devil. He will return in glory to usher in the fullness of His victory on the last day when the faithful dead are raised to share fully in His glory forever. We are blessed to be in a place like Vincentian de Marillac where this hope can be presented fully, and our residents can be supported in deriving true, consoling hope looking forward to the life of the world to come. I hope this good news of great joy that Christmas places before our hearts and minds will console all of you this Christmas and throughout the New Year!

We hope to deck out the chapel with some poinsettias for our Christmas day Mass and for the Christmas season (which lasts from December 25th through the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on January 9th). Please consider donating toward this effort so that our residents can enjoy the beauty of this season. Just send me a check payable to Vincentian de Marillac and put "Flower Fund" in the memo. Likewise, we still need Mass intentions. The usual donation is \$10.00 payable to Vincentian de Marillac, "Mass" in the memo section.
