VINCENTIAN MARIAN MANOR PET VISITOR POLICY

- A copy of the animal's current vaccination, including rabies, must be supplied to the facility receptionist at the **FIRST** visit. Only animals with current vaccinations on file are permitted on campus.
- Family may bring **ONE** pet to visit with their loved one.
- Pets may **ONLY VISIT WITH THEIR RESIDENT**. No animal contact with other residents is permitted (no petting/touching).
- Pets must remain in the designated visitation areas: resident's room or outside seating areas. Do not wander the campus or inside the facility.
- Pets must be **ON A LEASH** and under control **AT ALL TIMES**, inside or outside the facility.
- **NO animals** are permitted in areas where food is being served .
- Pet handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their pet (inside/outside) and disposing of pet waste in the appropriate containers.
- If you fail to comply with the policy, you will be asked to remove the animal from the campus and you will not be permitted to return.
